II. Empowers local communities for home stay hospitality

III. Supported home stay physical facilities (furniture, water, sanitation)

IV. Provided training on hospitality, hygiene, cooking, environment

c. Local Community:

I. Running home stays for the trainees; 15 houses with capacity of 30 pax. (Food and accommodation: Rs. *900/Day/Person*)

II. Contribute 10% of the income to Binayak Bal School
