**Established:** March 2016

**Location:** Badalgaun, Dhulikhel Municipality, Ward No. 8, Kavrepalanchowk

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**Objective:** To provide the physical facility and equipment for trainings, workshops, seminars, meetings.  
To promote education, health, social awareness and innovative works in the villages.

**Target group:**

- School communities and communities in the vicinities of Training Center
- NGOs and institutions to make use of the facility
- Volunteers and tourists for home stay

**Collaboration Model:** Triangular Self-Help entities

**a. School (Binayak Bal BS):**

- I. Ownership of the land, on which MMB TC is constructed. GNHA has a lease for 30 years.
- II. Demonstration of classroom procedures to the trainees

**b. Organization:**

- I. Invested in infrastructure/buildings and runs the facilities
- II. Empowers local communities for home stay hospitality
- III. Supported home stay physical facilities (furniture, water, sanitation)
- IV. Provided training on hospitality, hygiene, cooking, environment

**c. Local Community:**

- I. Running home stays for the trainees; 8 houses with capacity of 30 pax.  
(Food and accommodation: Rs. 700 Veg to 850 Non-Veg/Day/Person)
- II. Contribute 10% of the income to Binayak Bal School

**Run by:** Education Empowerment Center (EEC) – implementing partner of GNHA - up to 2023
